Works are to be delivered to the Upper Beaconsfield Community Centre Hall, 10 Salisbury Road Upper Beaconsfield on Thursday 12 February between the hours of 3pm to 6pm

PRESENTATION AND COLLECTION OF WORKS

Presentation of prizes awarded on Sunday 15 February at 2.45pm. All artwork to stay hung until completion of presentations. Art must be collected on the day of the festival between 3pm and 4pm

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Installation / Responsibility of the artist

- Please ensure your piece is mounted ready to hang
- Work entered is to be marked clearly on the back with the artist's name, phone number and the title of the work
- Please note - Nudes are accepted but please remember this is a family festival/exhibition
- Organisers reserve the right to not hang art if deemed unsuitable for a family festival
- Artwork will be displayed on boards provided by Rotary. Some artworks will be displayed on easels at the curator's discretion. 3D works may be displayed on tables, if a plinth is preferred artists are to supply.

Sale of Artworks

- If your artwork sells, there will be a 15% commission deducted at the time of payment to assist the running of the festival.

Responsibility to the artist

- Every care will be taken with artworks; however, The Upper Beaconsfield Village Festival will not be responsible for any loss or damage during delivery or exhibition. Any insurance is the responsibility of the artist.

Photography

- Photographs can be displayed on a cardboard mount or framed. Image area not to exceed A4 size.
- Details must be written on the back of the photo
